ELBERTA TO FOLEY:

Head west on AL-42/U.S. 98 toward Foley. / Turn RIGHT at AL-59/N. McKenzie St. and travel 1.4 miles. Turn LEFT at the South Baldwin Regional Medical Center Emergency Room (W.Wilson Blvd.) / Make a slight RIGHT at N. Bunner St. / Gulf Coast Cancer Centers is on the LEFT at 1703 N. Bunner St.

ROBERTSDALE TO FOLEY:

Head south on AL-59 for approximately 9.1 miles. / Turn RIGHT at the South Baldwin Regional Medical Center Emergency Room (W.Wilson Blvd.). / Make a slight RIGHT at N. Bunner St. / Gulf Coast Cancer Centers is on the LEFT at 1703 N. Bunner St.

PENSACOLA TO GULF SHORES:

Follow FL-292 crossing into Alabama which becomes AL-182/Perdido Beach Road. / Once crossing the FL/AL state line, travel approximately 8 miles. / Turn RIGHT onto Gulf Shores Pkwy/AL-59 and travel 1.6 miles. Turn LEFT on Clubhouse Drive and LEFT on Office Park. / Turn RIGHT onto Professional Lane. / Gulf Coast Cancer Centers is located at 253 Professional Lane.
